equipment and specialized staff training needed to rapidly respond, diagnose and treat severely-injured patients with complex, life-threatening injuries - from right here in our own community.



### **UPDATE: COVID-19 Vaccines, Booster Shots and Testing**

**COVID-19 Vaccines and Booster Shots:** Appointments can be scheduled through MyChart or the call center at 510.248.8200. Pediatric vaccines are available for children **6 months to 11 years of age**. We highly encourage people to talk to their health care provider about their medical conditions and whether getting an additional dose or vaccine for themselves or their children is appropriate.

**COVID-19 Testing:** Washington Hospital's drive-thru and walk-up testing tent is now offering COVID-19 tests to any community member that is symptomatic, or has a confirmed exposure. A physician's order is no longer necessary. As a reminder, testing at this location is not for travel, or sporting events. The tent is located in the parking lot of Washington West at 2500 Mowry Ave., facing Civic Center Drive. Appointments are required and can be scheduled by calling 510.248.8200.
